Accessing & Searching

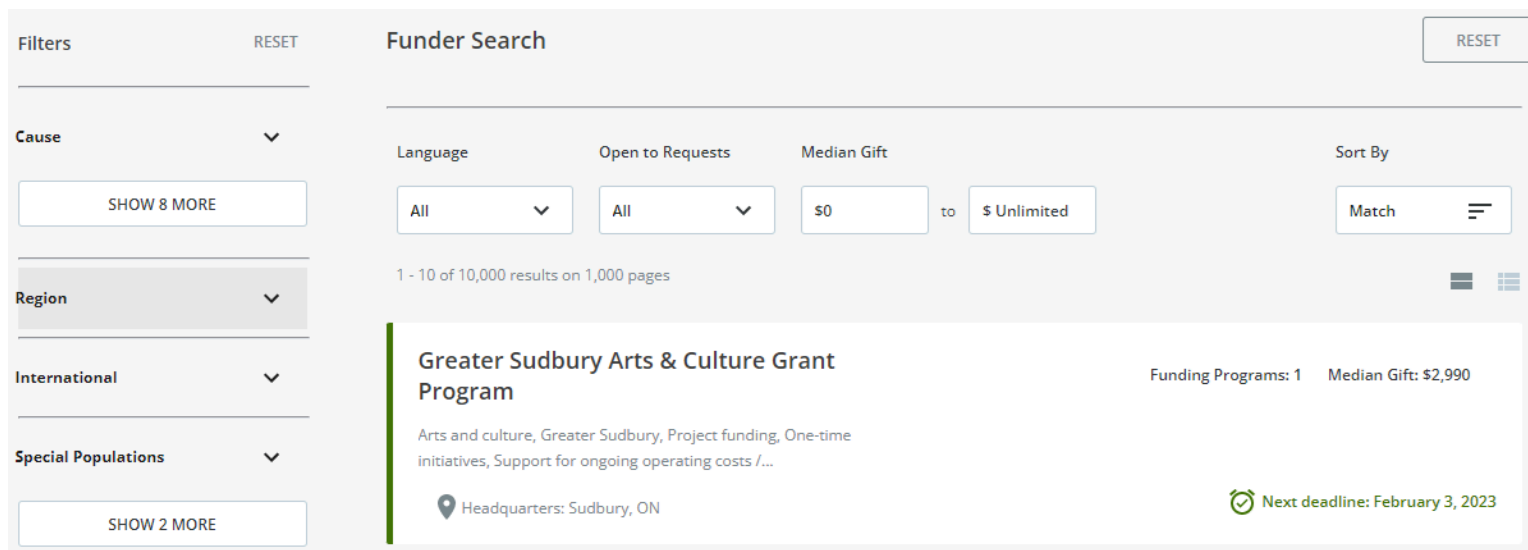
Logging On

1. Visit the library website and select **eResources**.

Searching & Navigation

Start your search by using the search bar at the top of the page to search for a foundation, cause, or a geographic area.

Narrow down your search by using the filters on the left hand side and top of the screen.
